Since its launch in 1975 the Group has played an important role in Scottish civic society in campaigning for law reform and increased access to justice. The Group also supports other organisations and their campaigns on issues which are relevant to the Group's aims and purposes. The Journal is widely praised for keeping people well informed about relevant developments through its news, articles and updates.

Proposals for reform of welfare law, legal aid, bankruptcy, criminal procedure, civil courts and tribunals, and employment law are all current examples of changes which impact on the lives of disadvantaged people and affect their ability to obtain access to justice.
